Hydrogen Sulfide (H₂S) Description: This course is provided to ensure that personnel working in H₂S designated areas on the North Slope can recognize the hazardous characteristics of H₂S and can correctly apply the standards, procedures and emergency response practices for potential exposures. The class covers the physical and health characteristics of the vapor, exposure limits, alarms, in areas where H₂S may be present. Any person with long term or temporary work assignment on the North Slope who must work unescorted in H₂S designated facilities.
